Focus: Disease, Insect and Weed Control

This beautiful landscape lends itself to the informal setting of the surrounding woods. Diverse plant materials and light conditions dictate constant technical supervision of the property. The property is characterized by perennial gardens, ground cover beds, paver hardscape and a lush turf.

Striking results have been achieved on this site because of detailed planning and execution. The expansive flower and ground cover gardens require constant care. Flowers are deadheaded weekly and pinches as needed. The plant beds are also hand weeded and cultivated during each site visit. Skilled pruning is performed to ensure that a natural look is maintained. Debris from large trees also must be constantly cleared from this site to maintain a uniform appearance.

There are numerous obstacles that are encountered and require continuous monitoring and care. Broadleaf and grassy weeds are controlled with a targeted use of pre-emergent herbicides. Post emergent herbicides are used in ground cover beds and to control perennial grasses. Increasing pressure each year from deer and rabbit browsing has been limited by using non-toxic repellent.
