The Lake House

When Howard Van Doren Shaw built the “Allegheny” estate on the shores of Lake Geneva in the early 20th century, he collaborated with legendary landscape architect Jens Jensen to design a prairie garden to go with it. Nearly a century later, another area landscape architect has rejuvenated and expanded the historic landscape, creating a lakeside oasis enjoyed by the homeowners and garden walk visitors alike.
